To celebrate the visit of Dippy the Dinosaur to the Dorset County Museum from 10th February, Weymouth BID has arranged for the installation of the most remarkable 17th Century wall mural of a diplodocus skeleton that may well have been Dippy's sister, Dippalina.

As a centrepiece for the town, this highly prized exhibit will attract children, families and residents from all over the borough to see this amazing piece of dinosaur history. The mural is recognised as being the next best thing to seeing 'Dippy' for real and worth many, many thousands of pounds!

Unfortunately... the installation team got their wires crossed and hung the individual mural sections in the 'best places' around town, instead of the whole mural in the 'best place' around town...

Whoops!

So, now we have 10 individually numbered sections of mural displayed in different parts of Weymouth town.

Follow the map on the other side of the form to find the 10 images, then try to work out how they fit together to make 'Dippalina' whole again.

Best if you photograph or sketch each section on your way round for reference or take a photo of the complete image on the BID window before you start, or both!
